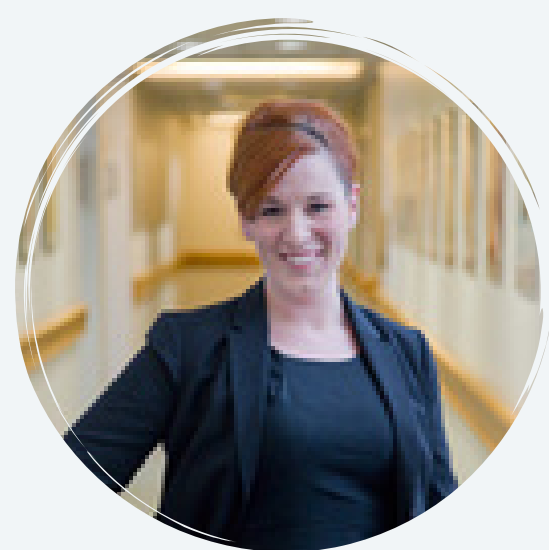
This training will assist health centers in developing or improving upon their data governance framework. Topics include:
